# Reid Bandeen

## Artist's Biography



**Reid Bandeen** is a contemporary impressionist landscape painter who began his creative explorations at an early age, where his middle school instructors bought his first paintings. He currently lives and works in New Mexico, where he follows his inspiration to celebrate the splendor of the western landscape. Though largely self-taught, he pursued formal studies at the University of New Mexico, the New Mexico Art League and via mentorships with various contemporary master painters, including Deborah Paris, Arturo Chavez, Scott L. Christensen, and T. Allen Lawson. Located in Placitas, New Mexico, Bandeen primarily explores the expansive panoramas and magical light of the American Southwest, throughout the U.S. and abroad.

## Experience Summary

Selected juried shows since 2010 include the Plein Air Painters of New Mexico annual juried show (6 years); Rio Grande Art Association "Encantada" annual juried show (3 years); Taos Art Museum Plein Air show (2019-20); Santa Fe Plein Air Fiesta (3 years), and Masterworks of New Mexico (2021). Mr. Bandeen was the featured artist at Purple Sage Gallery (Old Town Albuquerque) for one month during 2013 through 2019, and at One Artist Road (Santa Fe) in 2011. Awards include First Honorable Mention at the Plein Air Painters of New Mexico (PAPNM) Art in the Parks Show (2012) and the Jack Richeson Award at the PAPNM Annual Juried Show in 2012. A more detailed summary of recent experience follows.

#### Artist's Statement

To me reality is a feeling, and the true test of my painting is to ignite the feeling of awe and mystery I have experienced from a scene in the viewer. Conveying "feeling" in a painting can be an elusive goal, and is seldom achieved by literal reporting. Rather than simply report an observed scene in paint, a work of art is achieved via a unique and original combination of drawing, composition, design, value, color chroma, color temperature, and careful harmonization of each element of a painting interacting with all the others in the piece. Once achieved, this feeling is unmistakable and instantly recognized.
