Thursday April 25th, 5pm-7pm

Monica's Firehouse Grill

This is an Early Bird stamping and social event in the village. Great comfort food, This is a pay your own event. There will be a 10 % discount on food!

Friday April 26th, 6pm

Nomad Mountain Pizza

A pay your own opportunity for great pizza, salads and conversation. This will be followed by a bonfire at 8 pm, across the street from the restaurant, at **La Cueva Lodge**.

Note: These two events, though they have Jemez Springs addresses, are actually located at the juncture of Highway 4, and Highway 126, the La Cueva Corner, also known as the Fenton Lake turn off. The locations are 8.8 miles north of the village of Jemez Springs.
