JUDGE OF AWARDS

• Joe Anna Arnett - (joeannaarnett.com) Joe Anna Arnett has been a professional artist, featured in museum shows and prestigious invitational events for over 35 years. Working in oils, Joe Anna has taught workshops across the US, Europe and even Ecuador. She was a master artist, a producer and writer for the PBS series, Passport & Palette. She has been a featured main-stage presenter for Plein Air Magazine's Convention as well as a faculty member.

Arnett exhibited for 14 years at the Prix de West Invitational show and was featured at the Gilcrease Museum's 206 Rendezvous and is in their permanent collection. She has participated in museum shows from Albuquerque to Hong Kong. She is a Signature Member of Oil Painters of America, Laguna Plein Air Painters and a Master Signature Member of Plein Air Colorado.

Arnett authored the North Light Book Painting Sumptuous Vegetables, Fruits and Flowers in Oil, published in 1998. She has had feature articles in The International Herald Tribune, Southwest Art, Western Art Digest and North Light Books, Painting with Passion, The Best of Flower Painting I and II, The Complete Oil Painter, Sketchbook Confidential and Fine Art Tips and Tricks. Recent articles include Art of the West and Plein Air Magazine.

Arnett's paintings can be seen at the prestigious Zaplin Lampbert Gallery in Santa Fe, NM.

JURORS OF SELECTION

- Richard Prather (richardprather.com) Working in oils, Richard's work is best typified by atmospheric and rugged images of the American Southwest. A long time Signature Member of the Oil Painters of America and a Master Signature Member of the Plein Air Painters New Mexico, Richard's works is routinely seen in National Juried Exhibitions and select plein air events around the country each year. Richard is represented by Masterpiece Gallery Santa Fe, Santa Fe, NM., the Karen Wray Gallery in Los Alamos, NM. and Marta Stafford Fine Art Gallery in Marble Falls, TX. Richard lives with his wife Sharla and their dog Louie in Placitas, NM.
- Lee McVey (leemcvey.com) Lee McVey is a Master Signature member of Plein Air Painters of New Mexico, Master Circle member of International Association of Pastel Societies, and signature member of Pastel Society of America. She is also a member of Pastel Society of New Mexico. Her pastels have been featured in full-length articles in the magazines *Southwest Art, Pastel Journal, American Artist* and *International Artist*. Lee's work is featured in the books *How Did You Paint That? 100 Ways to Paint the Landscape* and *The Plein Air New Mexico Year*. Her work has been in numerous juried national shows and has garnered awards at local and national levels.
- **Brienne Brown** (briennembrown.com) Brienne was born in Utah and studied at the University of Utah, but graduated with a Master's in Chemistry. However, she soon realized that watercolor and plein air painting were her true passions. Since then, she has earned signature status in several watercolor societies, including the National Watercolor Society. Brienne's work can be seen in *Splash 17: Inspired Subjects, Plein Air Magazine, Southwest Art Magazine*, and *Watercolor Artist Magazine*. She currently lives in central Pennsylvania, traveling all over the US for plein air events and workshops.

ELIGIBILITY

• Open to all plein air artists worldwide working in two-dimensional media excluding photography and digital art, with the exception of PAPNM Master Signature members, who will be invited to show a plein air work, but who will not compete for awards.

• Accepted artists must agree to become, if they are not already, artist members of PAPNM* – annual membership fee is \$40.00 per calendar year.

IMAGE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Artists must submit 3 images of sample works online for jury consideration at CaFÉ™ www.callforentry.org
- All submitted work must be at least **80% completed en plein air** within the past two years. (Painted January 2018 or later.)
- All work must be original.
- No work done under the guidance of an instructor is eligible.
- Images for CaFÉ™ entry: Use JPG images of artwork only (no frames or borders), at 1920 pixels (min. 1200 pixels) on the longest side, at 300 dpi. 5MB max file size each.

ENTRY FEE

- \$45.00 (non-refundable) for 3 images paid via CaFÉ™ www.callforentry.org.
- Jury result notification will be emailed on or by January 25, 2020.

PARTICIPATION FEES

Artists accepted into the event agree to:

- Become artist members of PAPNM annual membership fee is \$40.00 per calendar year.
- Pay a participation fee of \$75.00 (non-refundable) within 10 calendar days of notification of acceptance. This fee goes toward event costs, such as food and beverages at the Kickoff Fiesta and Celebration Dinner which is a full sit-down affair at a nice Santa Fe restaurant.
- Hang artwork for sale for the duration of the event at stated commission.

EXHIBITION

Sorrel Sky Gallery, (http://www.sorrelsky.com), located in the heart of Santa Fe, will host the opening reception and show exhibit March 13 - March 27.

PAINTING REQUIREMENTS

- Two plein air works created during the event. These two pieces are eligible for awards. AND
- One studio or plein air work created anytime of any subject matter, may show in the exhibition by each artist, for a total of three works. This third piece must not have been previously exhibited at any PAPNM event. None of the third pieces are available for awards, even if they were painted during the competition. They are available for sale.
- The Gallery will <u>not</u> be able to hold a reserve piece for this show.
- Minimum price point required by gallery is \$500 for all hung work.
- Each dimension (length and width) of <u>any</u> work, <u>including the frame</u>, shall not exceed 26" (This includes the studio pieces). However, artists who want to show a competition plein air work larger than 26" framed, can opt to hang <u>one</u> work (instead of two). This larger work may not exceed 36" x 48" <u>framed</u>.
- All work must be sturdily framed or gallery wrapped and ready to hang with D-rings and wire. No saw tooth hangers will be accepted.

COMMISSION

• All work must be for sale. Artists will receive 50% of the sales price of the work. Sorrel Sky will receive 40% and PAPNM will receive 10%. Sorrel Sky Gallery will handle sales tax. Payment to artists will occur within 30 days of the close of the exhibit.

• All possible care will be taken of the work submitted to the event. The gallery will not assume responsibility for work improperly framed. Work will be insured while at Sorrel Sky Gallery.

WORKSHOP (Separate registration and fee)

Joe Anna Arnett workshop, "Still Life, en Plein Air", The subject of this workshop will be still life in the open air but the lessons to be studied are about light direction, temperature, values and composition. Subject is secondary to these important principles. The class will be a dynamic, fast-paced experience in learning, with nothing about still life. If the weather does not cooperate, the class will move inside Into Joe Anna's beautiful north light studio.

HOST HOUSING AND DISCOUNTED LODGING

- Host housing will be available on a limited, first come, first serve basis.
- PAPNM expects all artists who use host housing to gift a small painting to their host and to abide by common sense rules.
- Santa Fe Sage Inn will offer the discounted room rate of \$90/night (Fri-Sat.) and \$85/night (Sun.-Thurs.) plus a \$15 experience fee/night (includes parking and breakfast buffet) and lodging tax (15%) for two queen/double occupancy or single king/double occupancy.
